

Burke Centre Conservancy COVID-19 Pool Sanitization Guidelines

Burke Centre Conservancy (BCC) cares about the health and safety of our residents. As we open our pools in compliance to Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and the Forward Virginia Business Sector Guidelines, we realize we must implement stricter sanitization rules for staff and patrons. Below lists the guidelines we will be implementing in an attempt to limit exposure to the Covid -19 Virus:

- Bathhouses will be sanitized every **two hours**.
- All shared objects will be sanitized after **each use**. This includes the sign-in desk being sanitized between patrons.
- The deck will be sanitized/scrubbed routinely.
- Lifeguards not actively lifeguarding will wear masks at all times.
- Patrons not swimming will be required to wear masks at all times.
- The use of BCC furniture is **prohibited**, but personal furniture is recommended.
- Only three people in each swimming lane will be permitted.
- A maximum of **fifty** patrons will be allowed in the facility at any given time.
- Lifeguards will be enforcing the maintenance of 10-foot social distancing rules.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be provided.
- Residents will be screened prior to entry by filling out a Pool User Acknowledgement form.
