## Update Residential Traffic Administration Program (RTAP)

Thank you for participating in the recent Conservancy meeting regarding traffic calming measures for Wilmington Drive. Several issues were raised during the meeting, which we have undertaken to address. The information herein will cover those items to the extent possible at this time.

- 1. Karen Coad has indicated her desire to serve as Task Force Chair, Katie Ray has indicated her desire to serve as Task Force Vice Chair, and Chris Townsend has indicated his desire to serve as Secretary.
- **2**. FCDOT has indicated that the stretch of Wilmington Drive between Burke Centre Parkway and Windward Drive, identified during the Residential Traffic Administration Program (RTAP) meeting, represents the entire length of Wilmington for assessment purposes. Consequently, feeder streets to Wilmington Drive are included.
- **3.** Stop signs are not included in the VDOT document regarding calming measures, as stated during the meeting. However, they fall under a different category, which has a different process than the one that is currently being undertaken. As a result, there appears to be an alternate means for requesting stop signs by dealing directly with VDOT. If the task force desires, BCC staff can contact the responsible VDOT representative to pursue that alternative. It would be a separate process from the current ongoing one and would have its own timeline.
- **4.** We have received requests that future meetings be conducted later in the day. Consequently, the meeting start times of 7:00 and 7:30 p.m. are hereby proposed. Specific days of the week will be determined for each subsequent meeting based on FCDOT availability, BCC staff availability, and any time-sensitive requirements.

As a reminder, in addition to email we will be using existing Conservancy communication methods of the Conservator newspaper, the Conservancy website, the Buzz, and the Conservancy smartphone application.
